

Mombasa City Tour

Day Trip Itinerary

Morning

- **Pick-up:** Start the day with a pick-up from Mombasa Port.
- **Mombasa Tusks on Moi Avenue:** Visit the iconic ivory-shaped landmark symbolizing Mombasa's history as a trade hub. A great spot for photos.
- **Hindu temple point.** Get to know more about the Hindu culture and history.
- Explore **Mama Ngina Waterfront** for a scenic ocean view.
- **Fort Jesus Museum:** Begin with a guided tour of this UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore its rich history dating back to the 16th century and its role in the Swahili Coast's cultural exchange.
- **Old Town:** Stroll through the narrow streets of Mombasa's Old Town, known for its unique Swahili architecture, spice markets, and antique shops.
- **Market tour:** you get a chance to strike a purchase of local and fresh products.

Midday

- **Lunch at a Swahili Restaurant:** Enjoy an authentic Swahili meal featuring dishes like pilau, biryani, or fresh seafood at a local restaurant.

Afternoon

- **Haller Park or Nguuni nature sanctuary:** Visit this rehabilitated nature parks to see wildlife like giraffes, crocodiles, and hippos. Opt for the giraffe feeding session if the timing fits.
- **Bombolulu Workshop and Cultural Centre:** Explore local handicrafts and cultural displays, and support artisans with disabilities.
- **Drop-off:** Return to Mombasa Port.
